## **CLRSD Board Meeting 2-1-07**

1. Phase I-Lobster Lake

A. Jerry Haggenmiller will set up a February meeting with Bruce Nelson @ ALASD. The purpose is to establish a sub-committee having members from both organizations work on details affecting both, relative to the operation of the Phase III Mechanical Plant (lakes Miltona & Irene area)& Phase I (Lobster Lake) integration into the ALASD system. Bruce Nelson will be invited to attend the March CLRSD meeting

B. WSN Engineering firm is putting together new cost estimates for Phase I.

C. A motion was introduced & passed to have a income survey completed for Phase I.

D. A second motion was approved to apply for Rural Development funding for Phase

## 2. Phase II-Chippewa Lake & Devils Lake

A. Seventy Three income surveys were sent out. 52 were returned. To validate the survey, 9 more must be completed & returned. Rural Development will be contacted to see if it's permissible to put a article in the Lake Chippewa Lake Associations newsletter requesting the individuals who haven't filled out & returned the survey to do so.

B. Various motions were introduced & passed relative to Rural Development funding.

<>C. A Public Hearing will be scheduled for sometime this summer relative to the Phase II project.

It is possible the hearing will be expanded to cover a three phases.

D. The Tanglewood Addition to Devils Lake has been added to Phase II.

## 3. Phase III Lakes Irene & Miltona area

A. Plans for the Mechanical Plant must be submitted to the MPCA by February 22.

B.The MPCA permit to operate the plant is being held up until the Minnesota Supreme Court issues a decision relative to the Maple Lake/Annandale Sewer Project.

C. A recent environmental report was favorable to the Mechanical plant location.

D. The cities of Carlos & Miltona are still going forward with their plans to become part of CLRSD. The addition of Carlos alone would help the reduce TMDL load limits.

E. A February 15 meeting is scheduled for persons owning land next to the new Mechanical Plant property. The purpose of the meeting is to view the ALASD Plant operation & to show them where the Phase III Mechanical Plant will be located on plant property.

## 4. Misc. Items

A. The CLRSD board is considering adopting the ALASD assessment policy.

B. Springstead & Associates will be at the March meeting to provide a update of cost estimates for the Phase III project.
