Next item was how to handle the treasures position. In the next month various options will be reviewed and presented at next board meeting for approval.

As the projects move ahead, there will be many contracts and agreements that will need to be reviewed. The GM will research the area of legal representation and make a recommendation at a future meeting. The next regular meeting will be held on January 3, 2008 at 7:30 PM at Leaf Valley Township Hall. The aerial survey has been completed and is now ready for WSN to proceed with further surveying. Rural Development needs a few more items including an archeological survey for some areas. CLRSD is still looking at part of the package from Rural Development to include some grant money. The board was reminded that the funds for this project still need to be approved as part of the Federal Budget. THE GOAL REMAINS TO START CONSTRUCTION IN 2008. Tentative date for a special meeting to discuss financial options is scheduled for December 13, 2007 at 6:00 PM at WSN. A representative from Springstad will present various options.
